

Well-being and healthcare concerns of patients with advanced renal cell carcinoma: Findings from the EONS PROMs international survey

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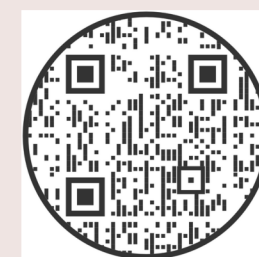
Background

- Renal cell carcinoma (RCC) accounts for 85% of all kidney cancers [1].
- Over 30% of cases are clinically advanced [2].
- 5-y survival 12% in metastatic RCC [2].
- Patients with advanced RCC face difficulties with day-to-day living [3].
- Patient-reported outcomes (PROs) provide crucial information to enhance understanding about what issues patients perceive to have the greatest impact on them [4].
- PROs can help promote person-centred approaches to treatment and disease management [4].

Study objectives

1. To assess patients' perceptions of adverse impact on core PROs in advanced RCC.
2. To explore moderators of this impact, which could point to groups of patients at greater risk for declining PROs.

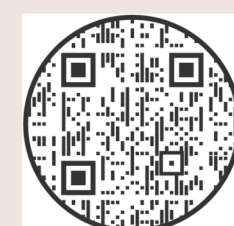

Methods

Prospective, international online survey.

Target sample size: ≥89 patients (95% confidence sampling, 10% error of margin).

Inclusion criteria:

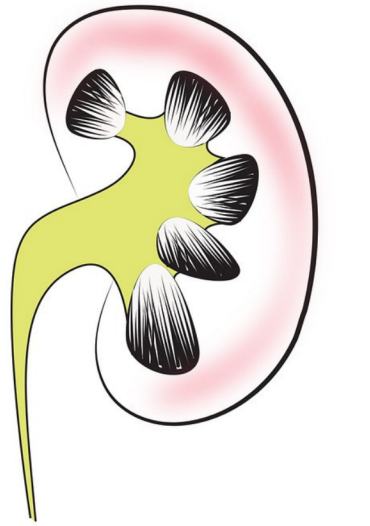
- Adult patients (≥18 years)
- Self-identified as living with advanced RCC
- Able to write and understand English.

Exclusion criteria:

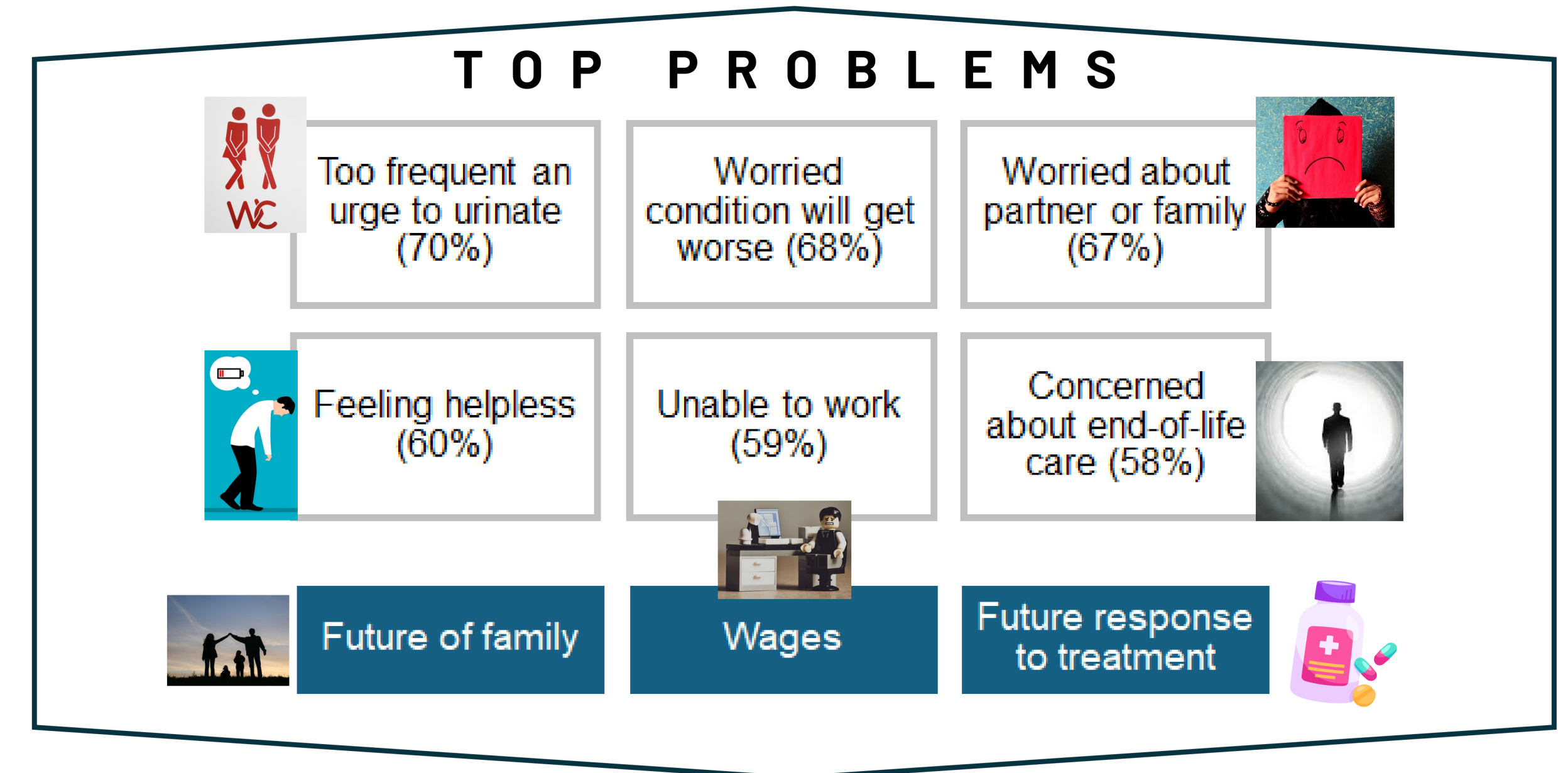
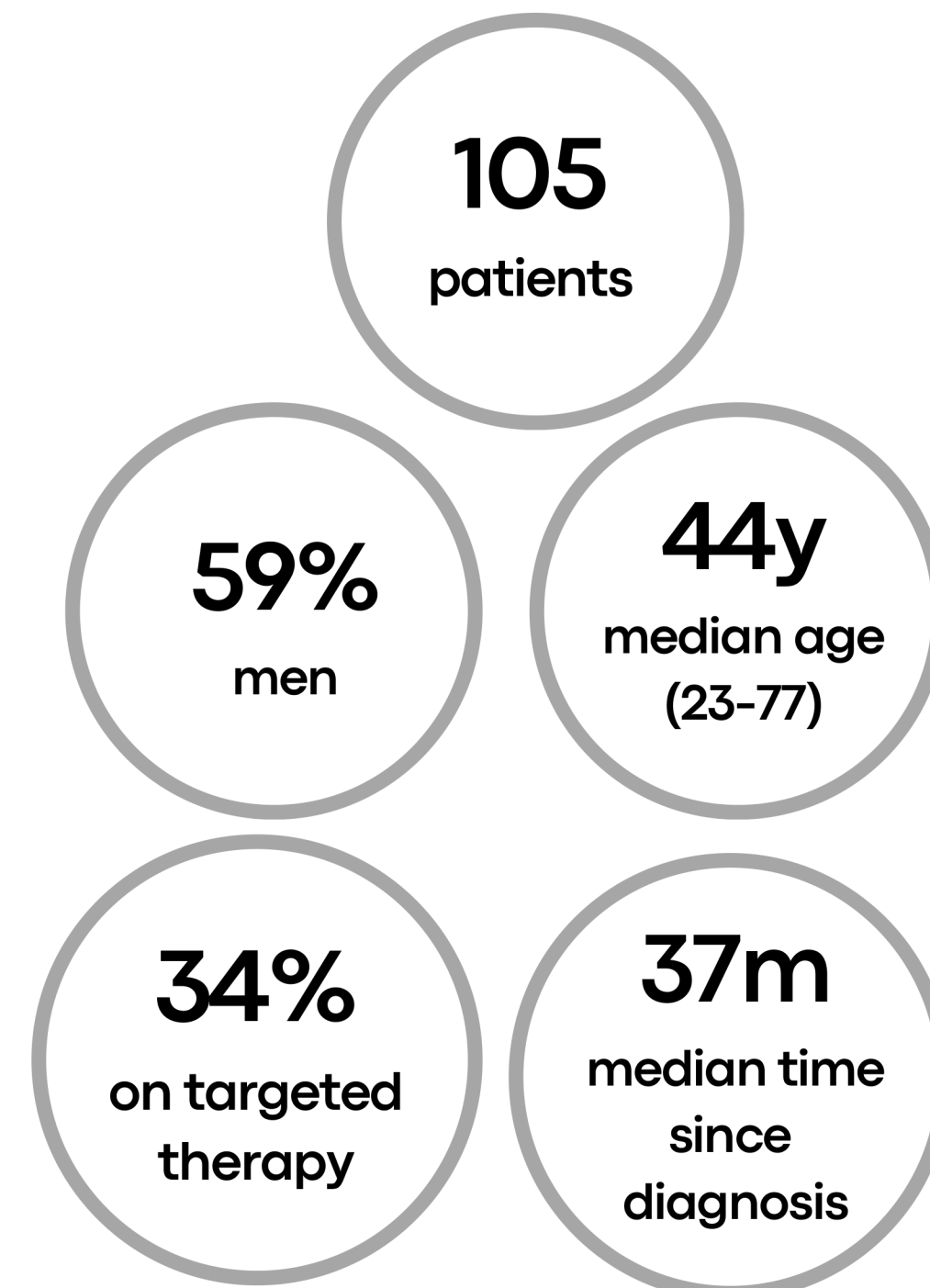
- No internet access
- Unable to provide consent.

Data collection

- Demographic/clinical characteristics
- Wellbeing - FACT-BRM questionnaire [5]
- Patients' top 3 priority concerns - open ended question.



Results



Younger age ➔ poorer physical and emotional wellbeing (p<0.001)
 RT or targeted therapy ➔ poorer physical wellbeing (p<0.05)

Take home messages

- Be vigilant - patients with advanced RCC perceive unique issues with their wellbeing.
- Identify, assess, respond, monitor - these are meaningful steps towards provision of enhanced person-centredness in survivorship care for advanced RCC.
