Reference values for interstitial tissue water in the head and neck area: non-lymphedema participants

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Purpose: To determine the test-retest reliability of a percentage water content (PWC) measurement protocol developed for the head and neck area in healthy participants; determine reference values, and explore cut-off points for lymphedema (HNL) diagnosis.

Methods:

- Developed measurement protocol (see video, figure).
- Test-retest 50 healthy participants
- Reference values 412 healthy participants
- Pilot with patients






Figure and video showing a visual reproduction of the measuring protocol

Take home message!

- Usable measurement protocol
- Average of three measurements
- Measuring around fibrosis and scares can be challenging







Results: Reference values (n = 412)

Conclusion: We established reference PWC values in a non-lymphedema population, for which we recommend taking sex and BMI into account.
